

Traditional (Full-Time) Membership

Welcome to Congregation Kneset Israel!

Please review the following policies, fill out the appended application and sign below. This application will be reviewed and voted upon at the next board meeting.

Every Traditional Member:

- May vote at all regular and special meetings of the Congregation.
- Receives High Holy Day tickets for self and dependent children.
- May purchase High Holy Day tickets for visiting immediate relatives at the special member rates, and according to synagogue policy.
- May enroll his/her/their children in the Religious School.
- May commemorate bar/bat mitzvah of self and Jewish children at Kneset Israel.
- May celebrate Jewish weddings, for self and his or her children at Kneset Israel.
- May participate in synagogue events, programs and services.
- May reserve a plot in the cemetery of the Congregation for self or dependent children, under such regulations as may be from time to time set up by the Cemetery Committee with the approval of the Board of Directors – such plots to be in rotation of their availability.
- May, as well as dependent children, be interred in the cemetery of the Congregation, rates determined by synagogue policy.
- Receives pastoral support from the Rabbi and Congregation at times of illness and grief.

Traditional Membership Dues for the first year:

Under 35

One Adult: \$600
Two Adults: \$800

35 & over (either adult)

One Adult: \$800
Two Adults: \$1000
