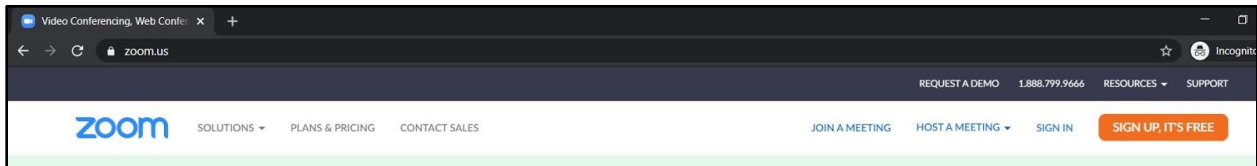


All participants in SAJ's online programming, including Makom, must have a registered Zoom account. Zoom accounts are free; simply go to zoom.us and click the orange "sign up" in the upper right hand corner. You may have *downloaded* the app and participated in Zoom meetings but did not actually register for an account. You will know you are registered if you have a password for your Zoom. Requiring registered accounts can deter unregistered intruders from joining our services and classes. This requirement will enable us to track who attends our meetings. And, if an unwelcome intruder were to join our meeting, we can also promptly report that account to Zoom

- Please go to [Zoom.us](https://zoom.us) and select the **SIGN UP, IT'S Free** button



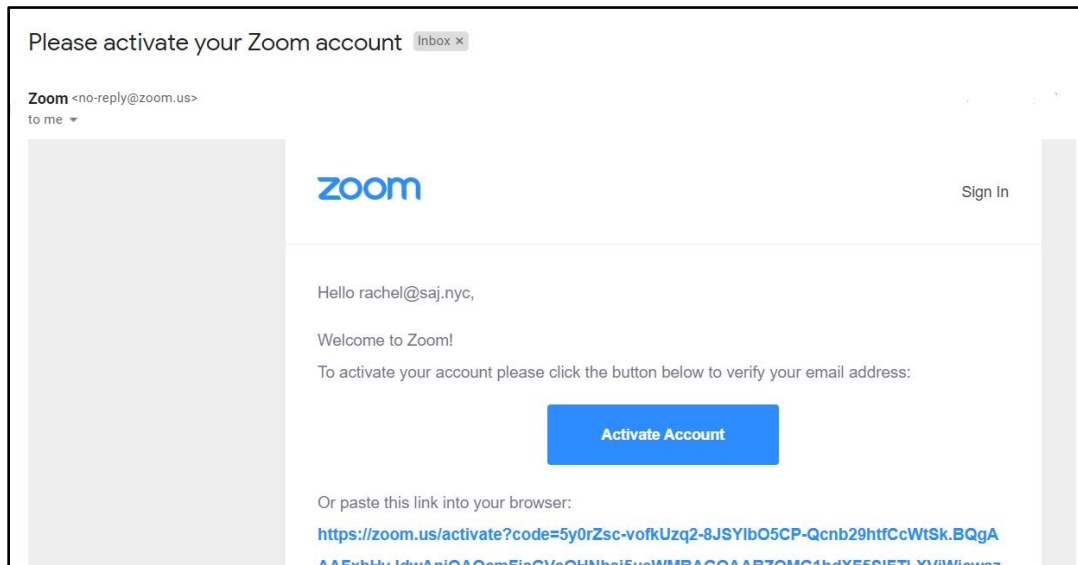
- You will be asked to enter your birthdate

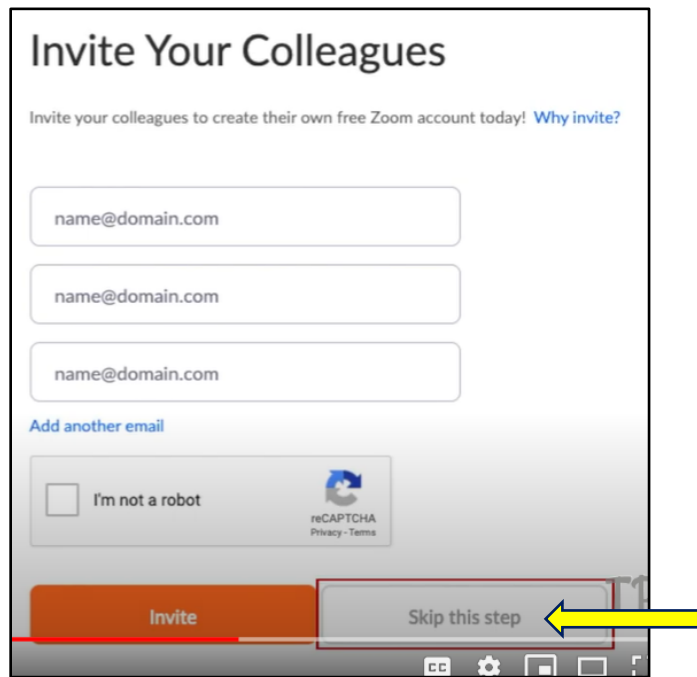
