
We are looking for a committee chair (or 2+ co-chairs) for our annual fundraiser.



These gift boxes are loaded with delicious Purim goodies and a Tribute Card. While supporting Congregation B'nai Tzedek, using this online ordering system makes Mishloach Manot (also known as "Shaloch Manos" in Yiddish) easier than ever! We make and deliver the gift boxes and you pay tribute to CBT families, clergy, and staff.

Here is how it works:

- Each CBT family will receive an individual email with a custom Tribute ordering link.
- Each CBT family (including clergy and staff) will receive **ONE** gift box, hand-delivered to their door or by mail for out of area members. Enclosed with the box will be a Tribute Card showing all those who made a tribute to CBT in their honor. Approximately 270 gift boxes will be prepared and delivered.
- To have your name appear on a Tribute Card, you can: a) make a tribute to specific members at \$10 each (minimum of 2), or b) become a sponsor for \$360 and your name will appear on every Tribute Card. Sponsors may order through the office if they have money on account.
- You may select Auto-Reciprocation for **\$50**, so that everyone who pays tribute to you will also receive a tribute *from* you, with no maximum. This is only available as an Add-On and is not needed if you are a sponsor.

Deadline for placing orders is Tuesday, March 12, 2024 at 5:00 PM

Orders will be delivered on Sunday, March 17.

FAO:

- Every family will receive a box even if they do not participate in the fundraiser.
- The maximum you can pay for tributes is \$360. Thereafter you will be considered a sponsor and your name will go on every Tribute Card.
- After placing your order, you may amend it up to the order deadline.


