Jay has offered to continue as Brotherhood President in the next fiscal year starting July 1. Also offering their services for another year are Ian, Corresponding Secretary, and Gary Miller, Publicity Chairman. Any male member of CBT interested in serving on the Brotherhood board may contact Jay.

Continuing our service to the temple, Brotherhood has agreed to fund the cleaning of 14 talitot owned by CBT, which are offered to those attending services. Estimated cost is \$170. We also will fund the purchase of nine or ten "walkie talkies" or hand-held radios for communication between CBT administration, staff and religious school teachers to be used in cases of emergency at the temple. Estimated cost is up to \$450.

We are already planning events for the coming year. They include a Dinner Dance, Aug. 10 on the CBT patio; Brotherhood Pizza Night, Sept. 19; Building the Sukkah on the CBT patio, Oct. 13; Bagels and Blintzes Under the Sukkah, with Sisterhood, Oct. 20; Veterans' Day program, Nov. 10; Movie Night, Dec. 24; Heritage Pointe Volunteer effort, Dec. 25; and Brotherhood Shabbat, Jan. 31, 2025.




