Continuing our service to the temple, Brotherhood has agreed to fund the cleaning of 14 talitot owned by CBT, which are offered to those attending services. Estimated cost is \$170. Estimated cost is up to \$450.

They include a Dinner Dance, Aug. 10 on the CBT patio; Brotherhood Pizza Night, Sept. 19; Building the Sukkah on the CBT patio, Oct. 13; Bagels and Blintzes Under the Sukkah, with Sisterhood, Oct. 20; Veterans' Day program, Nov. 10; Movie Night, Dec. 24; Heritage Pointe Volunteer effort, Dec. 25; and Brotherhood Shabbat, Jan. 31, 2025.
