WHAT IS US KIDS CLUB

Our in-person programs are places for our children to see other children, be part of a community, and have academic support.

WHAT DOES A DAY AT US KIDS CLUB LOOK LIKE?

- Each child will have a desk that is their dedicated work space. We will be creating marks on the ground for waiting in line for the restroom, etc. We will also use the words "stay in your bubble" and other ways to encourage children to be mindful of their space. Once it becomes routine it is much easier!
- Students will follow their distance learning from their secular schools and we will fill in the day with hands on activities, including art, science, and physical activities



HOW WILL THE CHILDREN WORK ON THEIR SCHOOL WORK?

- Your child must be enrolled in their secular school and receive distance learning instruction
- We will assist your child with completing assigned work during synchronous and asynchronous learning sessions
- If your child will be getting emailed assignments they must have access to this email or we must be added to the teacher's distribution list
- Our counselors are not teachers, our staff have backgrounds in child development and experience working with kids
 - They are capable to assist in learning but are not teaching a prescribed curriculum



HOW WILL THE CHILDREN BE GROUPED

- With a group size of up to 12 children and 2 counselors (mixed ages) the counselors will work hard to ensure to meet the needs of all children.
- Children will be grouped by family unit as well as extended family pods. We know families are socializing and we want this exposure to remain consistent at school
- Children will remain in the same class with the same counselors for the duration of their day of programming. We will not be mixing groups at all.



WHAT ARE THE PROGRAM HOURS?

- Our program hours are 8:30-2:30
- Early Care is available 8:00-8:30 (for an extra charge)
- Extended Care is available 2:30-5:00 (for an extra charge)

WEARING A MASK?

Yes! all our staff will be wearing face coverings at all times, except while eating. Los Angeles county guidance also requires children to wear masks, therefore we are requiring it as well. Your child must arrive to UniSyn wearing a face covering daily.



HOW WILL WE ENSURE PROPER CLEANING AND MAINTENANCE DURING THE DAY?

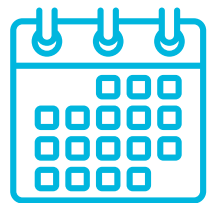
We will be following all of the guidelines provided by the CDC, Los Angeles Public Health Department, and the Department of Social Service.



- Children are required to enter and exit school with a mask. Children aged 2 years and older should wear face coverings, especially when indoors or when a six-foot physical distance from others cannot be maintained.
- Counselors will wear a mask at all times.
- Each child will wash their hands before being taken to their group spaces.
- If a child exhibits signs of illness during the day, they will be removed from the classroom with supervision by a staff member until they are able to be picked up
- Children will have their own bin of supplies. We do not have any communal supplies anymore. This is a big change but is done to minimize the amount of children sharing items.
