Poland & Prague

FAQ's

Q: When does the actual trip begin in Poland?

A: The tour begins in Warsaw on Monday February 24 at 10:00am and will end on Monday night March 2 in Prague.

Q: Will we all be together on one bus, or spread across different busses?

A: There will be only one bus, which will be led by Rabbi Wolf and Tzvi Sperber. The size of the bus will be determined based on the final number of participants.

Q: Will we be accompanied by security personnel?

A: Yes. An armed security guard will travel with us at all times.

Q: What will the weather be like?

A: Cold but not freezing. For that time of year, the average temperature is in the 30's Fahrenheit, and at night-time in the 20's. We advise: dress with layers; bring a rain-jacket, and comfortable/water-proof walking shoes.

Q: Is this trip a fundraiser program?

A: No, there won't be any solicitation of funds during the trip.

Q: Is this trip part of the March For The Living?

A: No. This trip is not related to the International March Of The Living, and is happening a couple months before the March.

Q: What is the total cost for the trip?

A: If you register before October 31, the cost is \$2600/person (after October 31, the cost is \$2800/person). If you are traveling alone and want your own room, there is an extra \$450 fee. To process your registration, we will need a \$750 deposit. Your entire balance will need to be paid in full 45 days before the trip.

Q: What is included in the cost?

A: 8 nights 4/5-star hotels; luxury coach bus, deluxe kosher catering, entrance fee to all sites, tips for driver/security-guard/local-logistical-coordinator, JRoots guidebook, audio-headset system

Q: What is not included in the price?

A: Travel expenses, medical insurance, tips for tour-guide, personal extras

Q: Are there subsidies available?

A: We are working to raise some funds towards this, and will know more a bit later. If you want to help towards this, please let us know.

Q: What language will the tour guides speak?

A: All tours will be in English.

Q: Are there suggested books/movies that can help us prepare for the trip?

Q: How else can we prepare for the trip?

A: Rabbi Wolf will host a few study sessions prior to the trip, which we encourage you to attend.
