Candle Lighting on Second Night of Pesach and Friday Night. The Berachah on the candles may only be recited if the room does not have any lights on, including electric lights. If the above scenario does not exist, the candles may be lit in another room where it is dark. Also, the candles must be lit from an existing flame.

Yizkor/Hashkavah Kelalit. It is a long-standing practice at Kehillat Shaar HaShamayim to show respect to those who observe Yizkor on the days the Ashkenazi communities worldwide do by reciting a "Hashkavah Kelalit", a communal memorial prayer. This year, for those who are unable to join us, names can be submitted for the Rabbi to recite during Yizkor via our online form which will remain open until Chol HaMo'ed.
