#### Services provided:

Emergency food.

Rental assistance: CFA can pay one month's back rent for people who have received an eviction notice, or the first month's rent on a new, more affordable apartment, up to a capped limit.

**Security deposits:** are available to people who have received Section 8 vouchers, and need this assistance in order to move into the apartment. (Seniors are not required to have section 8 vouchers). Payments are made directly to the landlords. If the tenant vacates the apartment, the landlord must refund the security deposit to CFA.

**Utility assistance:** CFA can pay one month's utility bill to prevent shut-off of services, or can pay for heating oil. Payments are made directly to the utility or fuel oil company when available, NJ SHARES can provide assistance in addition to our government funds.

Eligibility: Anyone who has a source of income either from work, written promise of employment, or other guaranteed source of income (SSI, SSD, Social Security, Worker's Compensation, unemployment, pension, etc.) sufficient to meet their housing or utility expense once assistance brings their situation up to date.

\*Note: Rental or utility assistance cannot be provided to individuals who have no promise of financial resources to meet their housing or utility needs on a regular monthly basis, or to anyone who is currently receiving welfare.
