Security Update: As part of our ongoing efforts to enhance our building security practices, and based on consultations and discussions with security experts we have made some changes:

- 1) The two access codes (the electronic code of the front door and the mechanical lock on the side of the building) have recently been changed. In addition, we will adopt the practice of changing these codes periodically. You will be notified via email when the changes are set to occur.
- 2) These access codes will be given to each Shul member and regular minyan or shiur attendee who requests them.
- 3) The new front door code will only allow access to the building for regularly scheduled tefila and shiur times. If you require access at other times, you may request your own individual access code by contacting operations@yipc.org and include your name, reason for access, times of access and your phone number.
- 4) During the week, all building access should be through the front door utilizing the electronic code. The side door should only be used on Shabbos and Yom Tov.
