Weekday Maariv Update: Beginning Monday night, January 6th, the weeknight 9:00pm Maariv Minyan will be discontinued for the duration of the winter. Mincha / Maariv b'zman will resume after Pesach. Sunday night Mincha / Maariv b'zman will continue as usual.

Shalosh Seudos Shiur: Rabbi Glasser will continue his Tefillah series, *Rav Soloveitchik on Tefillah: Reflections and Insights from the Rav*. The shiur will take place during Shalosh Seudos in the social hall. Men and women are invited.

Security Reminder: The exterior doors of the shul must remain locked during regular Shabbos and weekday minyanim and shiurim and other special events or programs. Based on recent events in Monsey and earlier this year in Germany, it is clear that locked doors may save lives. Please make sure that exterior doors close and lock behind you whenever you enter or exit the building. It only takes a few extra seconds to make sure. Do not assume that they will latch properly or that people who should not be allowed to enter the shul will not slip in before the door closes.

In addition, please continue to be vigilant and follow these common sense behaviors to ensure your safety and the safety of your family and our entire shul:

- Do not prop open any exterior doors, even if it is "just for a minute." If you see a propped or open door, close it.
- Make sure that your children are next to you in shul or are in youth groups and are not roaming around unsupervised inside or outside the building.
- Do not distract or allow your children to distract the security guard. (This includes engaging in conversation with the guard.)
- When something does not look right, report it to the appropriate authorities. This includes the security guard (if he is present) and shul leadership.
