Carl and Miriam Singer moved to Passaic in 1996. Not long after, they found a home with the Young Israel of Passaic-Clifton. When they came, there were older seniors and younger newlyweds. They and their children fit right into the middle – a true comfort zone. The Singers have been involved in a variety of community and professional organizations.

Carl was born on a westbound freight train along the Polish/Ukrainian border. After living in a Displaced Persons camp, he arrived in the United States at age $3\frac{1}{2}$ and grew up in Cleveland, Ohio. Dr. Singer has enjoyed a varied and interesting professional career. He was a vice president with the Enterprise Program Management Office at the Bank of New York Mellon, where he provided oversight and guidance to critical Information Technology projects. He also served as a consultant to the Institute for Defense Analyses, a Washington think tank. He previously served as a senior consulting faculty member at IBM's Advanced Business Institute (ABI), where he focused on issues related to effective management. He was a member of the technical staff at Bell Communications Research, and also served as a foreign exchange forecaster at Chase Econometrics and was a consultant to the Chase Manhattan Bank. A lifelong learner, Singer recently completed an MS degree in Homeland Security at Fairleigh Dickinson University with a focus on Terrorism and Cyber

Security. Additionally, he has a BS in Organizational Science from Case Institute of Technology and did graduate work there in Operations Research. He has an MS in Industrial and Operations Engineering from the University of Michigan and a PhD from Purdue University's Krannert School of Management. Carl has served on the YIPC Board in several capacities including Vice President of Finance, Secretary, and head of security for the shul. Carl is the immediate Past President of the Jewish Memorial Chapel in Clifton and currently, Chairman of the Board. COL Carl Singer, retired from the US Army with 31 years of active and reserve duty, is now the National Commander for the Jewish War Veterans.

Dr. Miriam J. Singer is an associate professor of education at Fairleigh Dickinson University in Teaneck, NJ and is the director of the QUEST program – a 5 year accelerated BA/MAT program. She was recently appointed department chair. She has over 30 years of K-12 classroom and administrative experience. Her BS is in zoology with a minor in math and physics from Michigan State University. Her MA from Eastern Michigan University is in special education, and her doctorate from Seton Hall is in educational administration. Miriam has taught at all grade levels from K-12 and at the university undergraduate and graduate levels. Fairleigh Dickinson honored Miriam this past year as Distinguished Faculty for her dedication and service to the University.

She has published in the Learning Consultants Journal, The Australian Journal of Early Childhood, Multicultural Perspectives, and has a recent book chapter entitled "Implications and Complications of Faith-Based Initiatives for Educational Programs". She presents at several regional, national and international conferences and is a frequent presenter at teacher workshops and in-service programs.

Miriam is extremely involved in the Jewish community. She has chaired a number of programs at YIPC including the goodie bags for Tot Hakafot, the Shavuot flowers, and Eva's Kitchen service project. 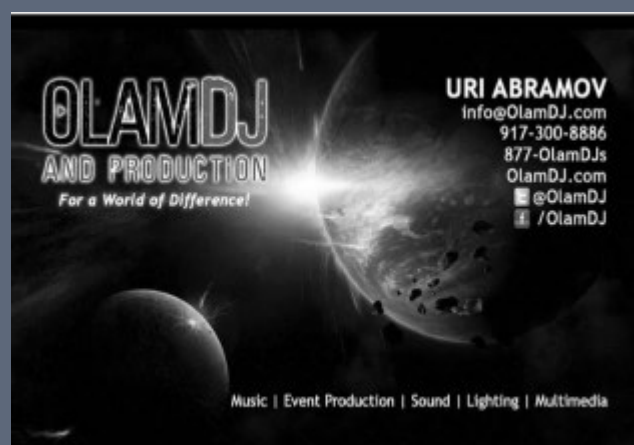
