## Drs. Carl and Miriam Singer

They and their children fit right into the middle – a true comfort zone. The Singers have been involved in a variety of community and professional organizations.

Carl was born on a westbound freight train along the Polish/ Ukrainian border. After living in a Displaced Persons camp, he arrived in the United States at age  $3\frac{1}{2}$  and grew up in Cleveland, Ohio. Dr. Singer has enjoyed a varied and interesting professional career. He was a vice president with the Enterprise Program Management Office at the Bank of New York Mellon, where he provided overght and guidance to critical Information Technology projects. He as a consultant to the Institute for Defense Analyses, a Vashington think tank. He previously served as a senior consulting faculty member at IBM's Advanced Business Institute (ABI), where he focused on issues related to effective management. He was a member of the technical staff at Bell Communications Research, and also served as a foreign exchange forecaster at Chase Econometrics and was a consultant to the Chase Manhattan Bank. 


