All the days of Enoch came to 365 years.

Enoch walked with God; then he was no more, for God took him.

ALIYAH #4 Gen 5:32-6:4

When Noah had lived 500 years, Noah begot Shem, Ham, and Japheth.

When men began to increase on earth and daughters were born to them,

the divine saw how beautiful the daughters of men were and took wives from among those that pleased them.—

YHVH said, "My breath shall not abide in man forever, since he too is flesh; let the days allowed him be one hundred and twenty years."—

It was then, and later too, that the Nephilim appeared on earth—when the divine beings cohabited with the daughters of men, who bore them offspring. They were the heroes of old, the men of renown.

MAFTIR ALIYAH Gen 6:5-8

YHVH saw how great was man's wickedness on earth, and how every plan devised by his mind was nothing but evil all the time.

YHVH regretted making human beings on earth, and was saddened.

YHVH said, "I will blot out from the earth the humans whom I created—together with beasts, creeping things, and birds of the sky; for I regret that I made them."
