Dr. Simon Fisher received his MD and PhD degrees from the University of Toronto Medical School. He received his internal medicine and endocrinology training at the Beth Israel Deaconess Medical Center at Harvard University. He received subspecialty training at the Joslin Diabetes Center in Boston and is currently a Professor of Medicine at the University of Utah.

Dr. Fisher is a distinguished physician scientist. His research investigates the pathophysiology and treatment of diametes, insulin action, tissue specific cross-talk, complications of diabetes, and hormonal counter regulation. He is a member of the American Society for Clinical Investigation and is named in Best Doctors in America.
