Children who attend Jewish summer camps are considerably more likely to retain a strong Jewish identity and affiliation than children who do not. Kol Ami has a scholarship program supported by the congregation, Trustees Endowment Fund, Sarah Cowan Endowment Fund and the Kol Ami General Fund to help to send our children to approved Jewish overnight camps. This program is available to children up through those currently in 11th grade. **To apply for any scholarship, the family's financial obligations to Kol Ami must be current.** Applicants will be considered based on the following criteria:

- 1. Financial need
- 2. First-time applicants, regardless of financial need
- 3. Other financial aid applied for or available to the camper
- 4. Community involvement

Please complete and return the application by February 29, 2024. Checks will be written to the camp or organization. All requests and distributions will be treated confidentially.

In addition to Kol Ami camp scholarships, many camps offer both aid for families with financial need and incentive grants, including special scholarships for first time campers regardless of financial need (typically \$1,000).
