Dues must be paid no later than 7/30/2021. Payment can be made ACH, check, credit card, or cash. B. Members may submit a Periodic Payment Form by 7/30/2021, which requires payment at least 40% of dues on or before 7/30/2021 and the remaining balance by 4/29/2022. C. Alternatively, dues can be adjusted by the Committee on Adjustments. Those who need to may submit a Request for Financial Need Adjustment, no later than 7/23/2021. All requests and financial information are held in strict confidence. D. Pro-rated membership: when a new member joins after the 2021 High Holy Days, full-year dues are payable for the current year, and the <i>following</i> year's dues will be pro-rated to account for partial year of membership. If requested, alternatives may be considered for new members, and HHD admission already incurred for the current year may be reduced to member rates.</p>

Frequently Asked Questions

How do I pay my dues?

We make it very easy to pay your dues online. Simply log in to the member portal at harshalomparkcity.org and go to the “my account”, “my transactions” tab by **Friday, July 30, 2021** and complete payment by credit card. If you prefer, you may send a check for the full balance. You may pay your dues for the entire year in one payment, or schedule automatic equal installment payments. Installment payments must be completed no later than **Friday, April 29, 2022**.

Is there a fee for paying with a credit card?

No, but we do incur credit card fee charges totaling over \$14,000 per year. When making dues and other payments, you may elect to contribute an additional 3% percent to cover those charges.

I'm having financial trouble this year. How do I request a dues adjustment?

All are welcome, regardless of ability to pay. The Adjustments Committee is completely confidential, and considers all requests for dues adjustment each year based on financial circumstances. What is the difference between Family and Single Adult Household Memberships?

Single Adult Memberships are not intended for households with more than one adult. If you are part of a family with more than one adult in the household, you should select Family Membership, regardless of the religious affiliation of other adults. Please confer with the Rabbi if you have questions about these classifications.

What if I want to support the synagogue, but I do not want to commit to a membership?

Membership dues cover less than 60% of our operating costs. We have a mortgage, and increasing security and repair costs. Over half our members have made extraordinary financial efforts to reduce our mortgage balance. If you choose not to join, please contribute at a level that suits you.

Do Har Shalom members need tickets for High Holy Day services?

No, but THS requests that members be in “good standing” to attend High Holy Day services. That means either paying your dues in full or having an installment payment plan in place by **July 30, 2021** and being current on your installment payments. Non-members are welcome to attend High Holy Day Services according to the Admission Policy.

Am I required to make a commitment to a Building Fund?

The reduction in our construction-related debt has been achieved by the extraordinary generosity of major donors and with the generous support of existing and past members. In addition, an anonymous congregant has contributed \$250,000 to establish a board-restricted endowment to help cover our mounting capital repair and replacement costs. We ask all new members who have not contributed to the cost of our facility to make a pledge to the Burn the Mortgage campaign and/or the Capital Repair and Replacement Fund. Please make a commitment that is appropriate for your family to assure a future for THS.
