HALACHA HOW TO

Tuesday and Wednesday of the coming week are Rosh Chodesh Cheshvan! Remember to recite Hallel!

Hallel on Rosh Chodesh has an unusual & interesting history. The Mishna does NOT list Rosh Chodesh as a day of Hallel recitation at all, as it is neither a Yom Tov, nor a day on which a specific miracle is celebrated (such as on Chanukah). The origin story of Hallel on Rosh Chodesh comes from a visit to a shul in Babylonia made by the 3rd century sage Rav:

Rav happened to come to Babylonia, where he saw that they were reciting Hallel on Rosh Chodesh. Unfamiliar with this practice, he thought to stop them, as he assumed that they were reciting Hallel unnecessarily. Once he saw that they were omitting portions, he said: I can learn from this that they are maintaining the custom of their forefathers, i.e. they know that it is a custom, not an obligation.

In hypothesizing how the custom began, R. Yechiel Epstein (Aruch HaShulchan) writes that we are praising God for the many times in our lives and in Jewish history, when the darkest night (no moon at all) was followed by a glimmer of hope, which then waxed into a full-blown source of light.

In addition, Rechov Yeladim parents are asked not to bring ANY food or snacks other than those provided by BDJ. We will send out periodic reminders about this policy.

In Case of Emergency: The shul will continue to maintain a securely stored supply of Benadryl and epipens (both .15mg and .3 mg) as part of the first aid kits that are in the office, Rechov Yeladim, the mother's room, and in the sanctuary. BDJ will not be able to guarantee that medication will be available for every condition or circumstance. **Congregants and attendees to BDJ and BDJ events will be encouraged to carry suitable medication with them when in attendance.**
