***Matan A. Koch** is the Director of Project Moses and General Counsel at RespectAbility, a nonprofit fighting stigmas and advancing opportunities for and with people with disabilities. A longtime national leader in disability advocacy and a wheelchair user himself, he leads Project Moses, RespectAbility's Los Angeles-based Jewish leadership project, and is also on the front lines in many other areas of RespectAbility's work. Koch was a Senate confirmed Obama appointee to the National Council on Disability until 2014. An inclusion expert, he has developed training and materials for many Jewish organizations, including Hillel International, the Union for Reform Judaism and Combined Jewish Philanthropies. He has also spoken and taught at law firms, and at Johnson & Johnson. He recently finished a 4 year term on the Advisory Council of Jewish Vocational Services in Boston, as their disability subject matter expert. A graduate of Yale College and the Harvard Law School, Koch began his legal career as counsel to the Procter & Gamble Company, where he rose to become the primary legal support for a \$2 billion portfolio of brands. Koch was awarded the Legal Aid Society Outstanding Pro Bono Services for 2013, based on a victory at the highest court of New York.*

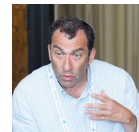

BDJ FOOD INCLUSION & ACCOMODATIONS GUIDELINES

As part of our general inclusion work and mission to be welcoming to all, we have crafted the following BDJ event guidelines for those with food allergies and other dietary restrictions. Thank you to Tzvi Wolf who spearheaded this project!

- ◆ We will continue to adhere to our **allergy policy guidelines** which state that we will try to keep all shul events free of serious airborne allergens and will label food that contain general major allergens.
- ◆ We will try to offer **vegetarian, vegan, and gluten free** options when possible for catered meals.
- ◆ When asking for RSVPs, we will ask for **special dietary requirements** and try to offer reasonable accommodations when possible. If not possible, we may (a) contact the individual to direct us to a separate locale where we can order appropriate food for him/her or (b) ask the individual bring his/her own meal and we will reimburse the cost of the event registration, depending on the nature of the event and the dietary request.

Though we will do our best to adhere to these guidelines, we cannot guarantee a fully allergen-free or special ingredient friendly environment due to the nature of working with an outside caterer. If you have serious allergies or dietary restrictions, please be in touch with the office to discuss.
