Most importantly, both he and Rabbi Kanefsky graduated from the Hebrew Academy of Long Beach in the late 1970's.

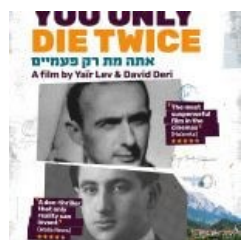
