Rabbi Michael J. Broyde is a professor of Law at Emory University and the Projects Director in its Center for the Study of Law and Religion. He is a visiting professor at Stanford Law School this semester, teaching Jewish Law. He is the author of more than 200 articles and author or editor of more than ten books. He was for many years a member of the Beth Din of America, and served as the rabbi of the Young Israel of Toco Hills for 14 years. He has been involved in the development of Halachic Prenuptial Agreements, including the Beth Din of America Prenup and the more recent Tripartite Agreement. He is married to United States Department of Labor attorney, Channah S. Broyde, and they have four children and grandchildren. Most importantly, both he and Rabbi Kanefsky graduated from the Hebrew Academy of Long Beach in the late 1970's.
