TRANSITION SHABBAT

Shabbat, August 25 | Rechov Yeladim

It's time to transition your children into the next age group in Rechov Yeladim! A new room, new counselors and new toys can be exciting for some children, but difficult for others. Please give your child adequate time to get acquainted with the new environment.

How Does It Work?

RY rooms have a birthday cutoff—September 1, meaning your child belongs in the RY room that corresponds to his/her age or grade as of September 1, 2018. Your child **stays in the SAME room for AN ENTIRE YEAR.**

The only exceptions to this rule are the baby & toddler rooms. Babies start when they are ready and at least 6 months old. Babies can move into the toddler room when they are ready & at least 18 months old.

Please note that there will be some children who will NOT be transitioning to new rooms. These include:

- **Students in combined rooms.** i.e. 2nd graders going into 3rd will stay in the 2nd/3rd grade room. 4th graders going into 5th grade will stay in Jr. Congregation.
- **Toddlers who transitioned mid-year** from the baby to the toddler room & children in the 2.5+ year old room who "just miss the cutoff." These kids "repeat" their year in the same room.

Children starting 4th grade should transition from RY into Junior Congregation. 6th graders will transition into Tween Minyan.

Counselors and staff will be available to explain it all and make sure that everyone makes it to the right group in the right room!
