*Meanwhile, here's a Machzor Minute teaser:*

One of the special and unusual features of the Amida on Rosh Hashana and Yom Kippur is the hyper-extended third blessing **שבתה קדוה**. What is typically a simple two-sentence blessing blossoms into a lengthy and moving liturgical composition, highlighted by the word **”ובכך”** which opens three of the expanded blessing's paragraphs. In an incredibly intriguing comment, R. Yaakov Turim observes that the choice of the word **”ובכך”** for High Holiday purposes is inspired by a verse from – of all places – Megillat Esther! Which verse, and what it all means, in the first instalment of Machzor Minutes!
