Attending Services and Gatherings

3 Simple Steps: Register, Log In and Attend Events

Have you logged in to the High Holidays web portal or app yet? All of our Elul events will be there, leading up to High Holiday services, which also can only be accessed through the web portal or app. (Both the app and web portal have identical content and features.)

Here's how to get started:

1

Register by filling out the form at the [registration site](#). (Skip this step if you've already done it.) Make sure you hit the **SUBMIT** button at the end of the form!

Sign in at the web portal: event.crowdcompass.com/havurahshalom. Use your name and email, then a verification code will be sent to you by email or text. A new verification code will be sent every time you log in. You are now logged in!

Getting the app: an email will be sent to you within 24-48 hours with links to the web portal above and to the App Store, where you can download the app if you choose. To get the app ahead of the email with the links, go to the App Store and search for CrowdCompass AttendeeHub. Download it, then search for our event, High Holidays at Havurah Shalom. Log in with your name and email, then a verification code will be sent by email or text. You are now logged in!

Attending events: After you're logged in to the web portal or the app, navigate to the Schedule and click into the event you want to attend. There will be a Zoom link there leading to the service or other event.
