The Adult B'nei Mitzvah process is for people who want to nourish their intellectual and spiritual selves, individually and within the context of an ongoing learning community. One might have never become a B'nei Mitzvah or they might have had a Bar/Bat Mitzvah – in form but not in substance. There are some things that you can go back and do again (but better this time)!

You will learn how to read Hebrew (or increase your knowledge), translate sections of prayers – while grappling with their spiritual and other meanings, engage a section of Torah through close translation and commentary, chant from the Torah, and navigate Shabbat services.

The pre-requisites are: 1) the willingness to learn and grow, maybe in surprising ways, 2) the ability to participate on Wednesday evenings during the school year as well as participate in monthly Shabbat morning services.
