## Lifelong Learning Committee charter

The Lifelong learning committee (LLC) will develop and help implement adult learning activities at Havurah. Adult learning falls into three broad categories: Expressive (handson, experiential learning, like cooking or constructing ritual garments); Culture (classes in history and literature); and Spiritual Practice (prayer, Hebrew, Torah study). Members of the committee reach out and listen to the interests of the community, mindful to be responsive to changing needs and interests over time. We offer regularly scheduled foundational classes, along with other creative learning opportunities.

The specific tasks of the committee are to:

- Plan and guide the Adult Learning programming, including working with the staff who provide Adult Learning opportunities and in communication with other committees who sponsor related programming (Spiritual Life, Tikkun Olam, etc.)
- Meet once or twice a year with representatives from the youth education committees to ensure cross-pollination of ideas and coordination of programming.
- Formulate and maintain an annual budget
- Help implement coverage during the Education Director's sabbatical
- Consist of a minimum of 6 congregants working in conjunction with the Education Director, the Program Director and the Limud Lead
- Address any education policy questions directly in conjunction with the Limud Lead
