The World Jewish Congress is confronting this situation on behalf of global Jewry, and the success of their effort — which could affect Jews in every corner of the world — depends heavily on whether you take a moment to sign our petition.

The very real and imminent threat Hezbollah poses must be exposed and confronted once and for all. The United Nations and other influential international bodies must stop treating Hezbollah as though it has a split personality and recognize that it is a single terrorist entity, and one of the greatest threats to peace, security and stability in the world today.
