### Sof Zman Krias Shema

- Halacha mandates that we recite krias shema every morning by the end of the third halachic hour of the day, which is known as "Sof Zman Krias Shema." We therefore do not always make it by the zman, we are careful to recite Krias Shema alone before the zman. When davening alone we do not have the same leniencies, and therefore one should try to begin davening early enough so that Krias Shema is recited before the zman (9:54 am this Shabbos). If that is not possible, please make sure to recite Krias Shema alone before the zman prior to davening.

## Kavod Shabbos

- Please remember that although we cannot be in shul this Shabbos, there is an obligation to honor Shabbos by wearing special Shabbos clothing. Doing so will also help us feel like it is Shabbos in the absence of our usual Shabbos structure.
- Everyone is encouraged to light candles 5 minutes early if possible, as a merit for Hashem to protect us during this time.
- Mincha should be recited before sunset, and everyone is encouraged to daven "together" at our normally scheduled time.

## Minyan Registration

The next Registration for minyanim for this week will be Wednesday for the following week beginning with Friday evening Mincha / Kabalos Shabbos / Maariv davening extending through the following Friday morning Shacharis.

## Tefilah on Shabbos and Other Shabbos Considerations

- Kabbalas Shabbos - The regular kabbalas shabbos is recited even when davening alone. It may be recited immediately following mincha.
- Maariv -
  - ◇ There is a benefit to waiting to daven Maariv so that krias shema will be recited after tzeis hakochavim. If that is too difficult, one may daven Maariv immediately after sunset.
  - ◇ *ויכולו* after shmoneh esrei is recited even when davening alone. There is a benefit for a man above bar mitzvah to recite it together with another man above bar mitzvah, if possible.
  - ◇ The three paragraphs following *ויכולו* (the bracha and *מגן אבות*) are not recited when davening alone.
- Shacharis -
  - ◇ Shmoneh esrei of shacharis should not be recited before sunrise, and everyone is encouraged to daven "together" at our normally scheduled times, either 7:10 am or 9 am.
- Krias HaTorah -
  - ◇ Although reading the Torah is a Chovas Hatzibur - a communal responsibility, which means without a minyan that obligation does not exist, everyone is encouraged to read through the parshiyos, maftir, and haftorah on their own.
  - ◇ The obligation of *שנים מקרא ואחד תרגום*, to read the parsha twice with a commentary, still exists, even though we are not leining as a tzibbur.
  - ◇ The Parshiyos and Haftorah are listed on the upper left of the other side of this page.
- Mussaf -
  - ◇ The two paragraphs that begin with *יקום פורקן* and the following *מי שברך* are omitted when davening alone (some recite the first *יקום פורקן*).
  - ◇ *יהי רצון* for *שבת מברכים*. Rosh Chodesh Cheshvon is Sunday and Monday. The molad is Shabbos morning, 23 minutes and 0 chalakim past three.
  - ◇ *אב הרחמים* is omitted this Shabbos.
- Mincha -
  - ◇ Please see the zmanim listed on the upper left of the other side of this page for the earliest time to daven mincha. Mincha must be recited before sunset.
  - ◇ *צדקתך צדק* is omitted this Shabbos.
  - ◇ Everyone is encouraged to daven "together" at our normally scheduled times, either 1:45 pm or this Shabbos 5:50 pm
- Please remember to eat *סעודה שלישית* before sunset. As long as one begins their meal before sunset, one may continue eating after sunset, and one should add *רצה* in bentching.
- Maariv (Motzai Shabbos) -
  - ◇ Everyone is encouraged to daven "together" at our normally scheduled time, which is 6:55 pm this Motzai Shabbos.
