**TIME TO REGISTER FOR THE JEWISH
HERITAGE SCHOOL AT HABONIM
(FORMERLY HABONIM HEBREW SCHOOL)**

We have been busy over the summer months preparing for the new school year. Our school has a new name and website, a new format, expanded grades, and the ability to pay fees online (please see instructions below).

The Jewish Heritage School now operates from 10am - Noon for all levels and has expanded to include grades 1 and 2, and goes up to grade 6. If you haven't already done so, please take a moment to visit our new website at www.jewishheritageschool.wordpress.com, where you will find the School Year Calendar, application forms and curriculum outlines for the coming year.

We also have a wonderful Bnei Mitzvah program for those in grades 7 and 8. It is designed to help young people explore issues of Jewish identity. As they become adult members of the Jewish community, there are a number of identity issues that arise and the program seeks to support and guide students to come to their own answers. The program explores issues of ritual and symbolism, participation in community, and expressions of identity. The Bnei Mitzvah program takes place on Sunday afternoons 4 - 5:30pm.

The deadline for applications and payment is

Friday, September 3, 2010. Note that space is limited and filling up quickly.

The first day of school is Sunday, September 19, 2010.

The application form can be accessed, completed, saved from our website at www.jewishheritageschool.wordpress.com, and emailed to habonimschool@gmail.com, and fees can be paid online through the Congregation Habonim website at www.congregationhabonim.org. From the left-hand menu, select "Pay Fees Here" and complete the necessary fields. School fees are \$650 for members of Congregation Habonim and \$750 for non-members. Bnei Mitzvah program fees are included for those holding a Bar Mitzvah at Habonim, otherwise fees are \$500 for members, and \$550 for non-members.

LEAD SPONSORSHIP OPPORTUNITY FOR HABONIM FILM SERIES

Beginning in 2009, Congregation Habonim launched a new film series featuring top Jewish themed films including films produced/written/directed by some Habonim members from the industry.

These Habonim film nights have played to many

full houses, and along with special speakers and entertainers, have been an extremely positive addition to our congregation.

To help build on this success, Congregation Habonim is opening up an opportunity for a lead sponsor for the Jewish year 5771 – beginning in October 2010.

Why sponsor the Habonim Film Series?

For a company, the opportunity would include:

- The 5771 series would be named “Habonim Film Series, sponsored by ABC Inc.”. This would be included in all emails, advertising, etc.
- There would be an ability to present the film (speak for a couple of minutes) at each film.
- There would be an ability to distribute marketing material to all attendees at the event.
- You would have 4 reserved seats at each screening.
- There would be a minimum of 5 films during the year.

For an individual, the opportunity would include:

Who is the audience?

As you might imagine, the audience to date has been Jewish, mostly central Toronto located, primarily age 50+. If this group is part of the core market for your business, this opportunity could provide a great return on your sponsorship dollar.

What is the cost?

One year, lead sponsorship is \$10,000.

Why is Habonim looking for a sponsor?

The first year of the Habonim Film Series has been a great success. Our “suggested \$10 contribution” covers some, but not all of the costs of events. We are very reluctant to adjust this suggested contribution approach.

We are excited about continuing and growing the Film Series, but without some additional financial support, it will be difficult to maintain the quality of speakers and films.
