DEAR MEMBERS OF HABONIM

As many of you know, I was diagnosed with Inflammatory Breast Cancer on June 5, 2003. It was the day after my third wedding anniversary, my son was 16 months old and I was 35 years old. Ten or eleven years ago my chances for survival of this type of cancer would have been 5%. Because of research into new and better protocols for the treatment of this particularly vicious cancer the survival rates have increased to better than an 75% survival rate. I am grateful and lucky to be one of them.

In addition to the research into protocols, from which I and my family have benefited. There are new and better drugs available to me for continued treatment to avoid a recurrence of breast cancer. The aromatase inhibitor I am on will decrease my chance of a recurrence to less than 8%. Without research into new and better drugs, I would not have this advantage.

I am also lucky to be allowed to have genetic testing in order to determine whether I carry BCRA1 or BCRA2, which are genetic mutations linked to an increased risk of developing breast cancer. I have learned that for women who fit my profile, 95% of the mutations are in three specific places in the genomic sequence. The lab will look for these mutations first. If I do not have one of the typical mutations, the lab will search through my entire genomic sequence to determine whether I have another mutation. Determining whether I have one of the breast cancer genes will affect my decisions about my care and will affect my sister, son and cousins' future health care. This tool would not be available if no one had funded the research.

Research into breast cancer has saved my life and continues to preserve it. Now I want to help fund it. I, together with my son Max and my husband Gil, will be participating in the Run for the Cure on October 3, 2004.
