A LETTER FROM THE PRESIDENT JOSH KOHN

In both our family lives and our lives as synagogue leaders, eventually the whirlwind of the High Holidays, Sukkot, and Simhat Torah slows down, and we get a bit of a lull before Thanksgiving and the excitement of December and the secular New Year. Sadly, that respite and lull that we were all awaiting was shattered by the tragic attacks in our beloved Israel. As Rabbi Witkovsky beautifully reminded us all, when the worst imaginable events occur, we pray and take solace in one another. He also reminded us that we still sanctify the special moments and the good things in our lives as a community, as the extraordinary does not cancel out the ordinary. And of course, we continue to celebrate Shabbat.

I was never a regular Shabbat attendee. Before moving to Philadelphia, I would try to show up at my shul when I heard there was going to be a great caterer, but most weeks I was more likely to be seen on the tennis courts. Things changed for me when we joined TBH-BE.

Sometimes I feel like a broken record, but the energy in our community right now is electric, and Shabbat mornings are a big part of it. Our Tot Shabbat and Youth Services are thriving and growing, and our wonderful Rabbi and Hazzan keep us engaged in the sanctuary. After services, we all join for community and connection with a large kiddush. I am always blown away that every Saturday, week in and week out, rain and snow, summer and winter, between 175 and 500 people join us for kiddush, racing to the buffet line. In these moments, when I have the opportunity to greet congregants and help serve lunch, I deeply feel the warmth of the community.

It also feels like there is rarely just a "regular" Shabbat anymore. Thanks to the generosity of our members, almost every week one or more congregant sponsors our kiddush. It is so special that we are sharing our happiest moments, our b'nai mitzvah, our aufrufs, our baby namings, our anniversaries, as well as our cherished memories of departed loved ones, when we acknowledge special yahrzeits with our community. The choice that so many of us elect to commemorate special life occasions, not just with our immediate family and close friends but with the greater TBH-BE community, is what makes me come back every week for more (the tuna and egg salad are really good as well).

In just the past few weeks, we have shared many of these beautiful community moments. The Forsteds commemorated their 55th wedding anniversary, Lewis Hoch and Alan Haber remembered their beloved spouses, the Apples and Finders celebrated the aufrufs of their children, and the Hoffmans celebrated Emily's bat mitzvah. In addition, the L'Chaim group generously sponsored our celebration of the 65th anniversary of TBH-BE. It was a truly special day, which those of us in attendance will not soon forget.
